





Crime Scene Case Notes

From the notebook of Detective Vincent Drains

AT THE SCENE WITH THOUSANDS OF CREATORS AND FANS

The Clog Monster was spotted wreaking havoc in the pipes and under the streets of Anaheim. But not to fear...hard-boiled sleuth **Detective Vincent Drains**, and his very surprising partner - a real-life singing and talking toilet named Mel - were on the case.

To **kick-off Flush Smart Month**, the dynamic duo invited attendees to help **uncover the cause of a costly toilet crimes at VidCon Anaheim (which celebrates and spotlights digital culture).** Together, they educated citizens on the importance of looking for the "Do Not Flush" symbol on non-flushable wet wipes packaging and the dire consequences of flushing things that don't belong down the drain.

The "toilet crime scene" uncovered the realities of careless flushing behaviors and how our pipes and environment are taking the hit. Attendees were challenged to recognize their own toilet crimes by taking a quiz to uncover clues on what should not be flushed and joining Detective Drains as a crime scene investigator via a TikTok duet. This activation flipped the switch on what, why, and how poor flushing behaviors are literal toilet crimes, and why they need to be stopped immediately.

Why was RFA at VidCon?


